**COFFEE MAKER** MODEL KF 5110/5210



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## Components

- A. ON/OFF switch with power indicator light
- B. Water tank
- C. Water level indicator
- D. Hinged lid
- E. Filter holder with antidrip valve
- F. Microwave proof coffee jug with fresh water graduation on both sides
- G. Warming plate
- H. Extendable power cord & plug
- I. Aroma button
- J. Measuring spoon
- K. Permanent filter

### Read the following instruction carefully before using the appliance for the first time.

- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- The appliance may only be connected to a power supply whose voltage and frequency comply with the specifications on the rating plate!
- Never use or pick up the appliance if
  - the supply cord is damaged,
  - the housing is damaged.
- The appliance must only be connected to an earthed socket. If necessary an extension cable suitable for 10 A can be used.

- If the appliance or the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified person, in order to avoid hazard.
- Always place the appliance on a flat, level surface.
- The appliance must be switched off and the mains plug withdrawn before cleaning and maintenance.
- The appliance and accessories become hot during operation. Use only designated handles and knobs. Allow to cool down before cleaning or storage.
- The mains cable must not come into contact with any hot parts of the appliance.
- Do not immerse the appliance in water or any other liquid.
- Do not exceed the maximum filling volume as indicated on the appliances.
- Do not use or place the appliance on a hot surface or near source of heat
- · Appliance is for indoor use only.

 This appliance is intended for domestic use only. The manufacturer cannot accept any liability for possible damage caused by improper or incorrect use.

### Getting started

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 Place the machine on a flat surface. When starting the machine for the first time, fill the tank with cold water. Start the machine with the ON/OFF switch. Let a full tank of water pass through the machine once or twice to clean it, permanent filter fitted without using paper filter or coffee. The jug is microwave proof.



2. Making coffee: open the lid and fill the water tank with fresh cold water up to the desired level. There is a fresh water gauge for 2–10 big cups / 4–15 small cups in the water tank and on the coffee jug. (The machine must not be used with empty tank!)



3. Insert permanent filter in the filter holder and fill it with ground coffee.

As an option a size 1x4 paper filter can be used instead of the permanent filter.

There is a gauge for recommended number of spoons of coffee next to the water gauge.


For average strong coffee 1 measuring spoon (approx. 6-7 g) per cup is sufficient. Close the water tank lid and place the jug back (complete with lid).



4. Start the machine with the ON/ OFF switch. The power indicator light will come on and hot water will flow into the filter. If the machine is not turned off manually, the Safety Auto-Off function turns it off after 120 minutes.



5. If the jug is removed, the filter valve prevents coffee from dripping onto the warming plate. (While preparing coffee, the jug must not be removed for longer than 30 seconds or the filter will overflow.)



6. The Aroma Selector extends the brewing time to maximize the flavour extraction and get a stronger coffee for a small number of cups (normally less than 6). Press the Aroma button, the light will turn on.



 Turn the machine off and unplug the power cord. Wipe all outer surfaces with a damp cloth. Coffee jug and jug lid are dishwasher proof.
 Never use caustic or abrasive cleaners, and never immerse the machine in liquid!

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 To clean the permanent filter, remove from the machine, wash with warm soapy water and rinse well with plain water.



3. To clean the filter holder, lift up the handle and remove the filter holder. To clean the filter valve thoroughly, push it several times while it is being rinsed. The filter holder can also be washed in the dishwasher.



4. Decalcifying is recommended regularly, depending on water hardness. Fill the tank with water and decalcifier according to product instructions, then follow steps 4 and 5.



5. Place the coffee jug with its lid onto the warming plate. Allow the decalcifier to take effect for about 15 minutes, then switch the machine on. Switch it off when the solution has finished flowing through. If necessary repeat the decalcifying process.



6. Allow the machine to run at least twice with plain water. Then thoroughly rinse the coffee jug, lid and filter holder under running water, activate the filter valve repeatedly during the rinse process.

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# **Disposal** *Packaging materials*

The packaging materials are environmentally friendly and can be recycled. The plastic components are identified by markings, e.g. >PE<, >PS<, etc. Please dispose the packaging materials in the appropriate container at the community waste disposal facilities.

- 3. The Purchaser shall use only genuine AEG accessories.
- 4. This warranty does not apply to light bulbs, external electrical connections, flex and all other items where the length of life depends upon the use and care given.
- This warranty shall only apply to appliances purchased in and retained for use in South Africa, Namibia, Lesotho, Botswana and Swaziland.
- The Purchaser shall not remove the serial number of the appliance.
